

MANDURAH ENTRANCE ROAD

Changing traffic conditions on Mandurah Road

Southern Gateway Alliance (SGA) would like to notify road users that the current traffic conditions on Mandurah Road in Mandurah will soon change.

The changes will allow the Mandurah Entrance Road intersection and associated tie-in works to be constructed in a number of stages.

The first stage is expected to commence next week and will include the construction of two temporary crossovers on Mandurah Road, which will enable traffic modifications in the later stages of the construction sequence.

Lane closures will be implemented around the work site during off peak times on weekdays only. Weekends and peak periods will not be affected.

Road users are advised that traffic management including speed restrictions will be in place and asked to take care when approaching the site.

The second stage of the construction sequence is expected to commence around March 2010, at which time long term lane closures will be in place. Further information and details about the next phase and associated works will be issued shortly.

SGA apologises for any inconvenience during the works and thanks residents and road users for their patience and cooperation.
